At 8:05 pm, the meeting was adjourned. Eleven members went to Chili's for dinner.



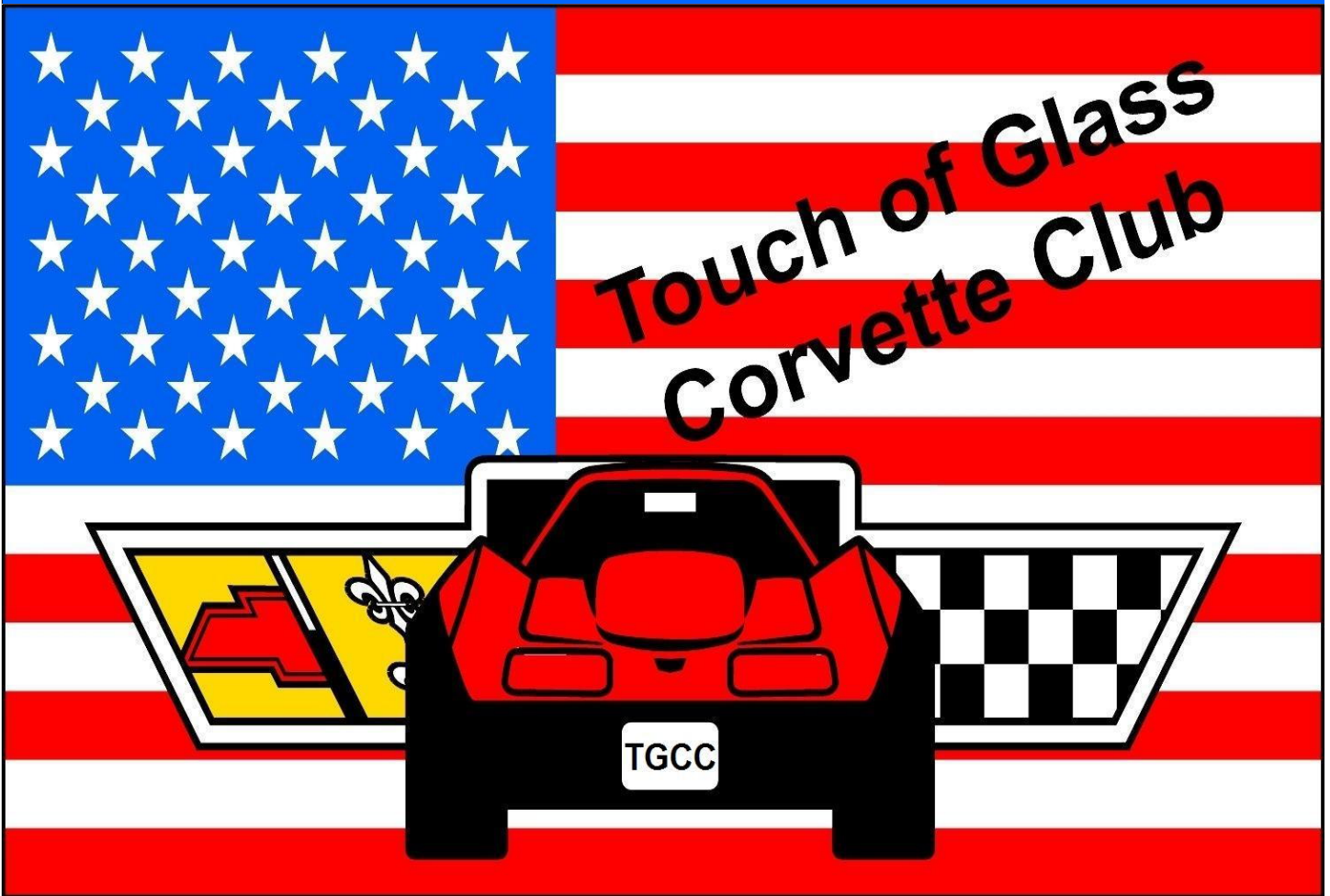
