NEW BUSINESS

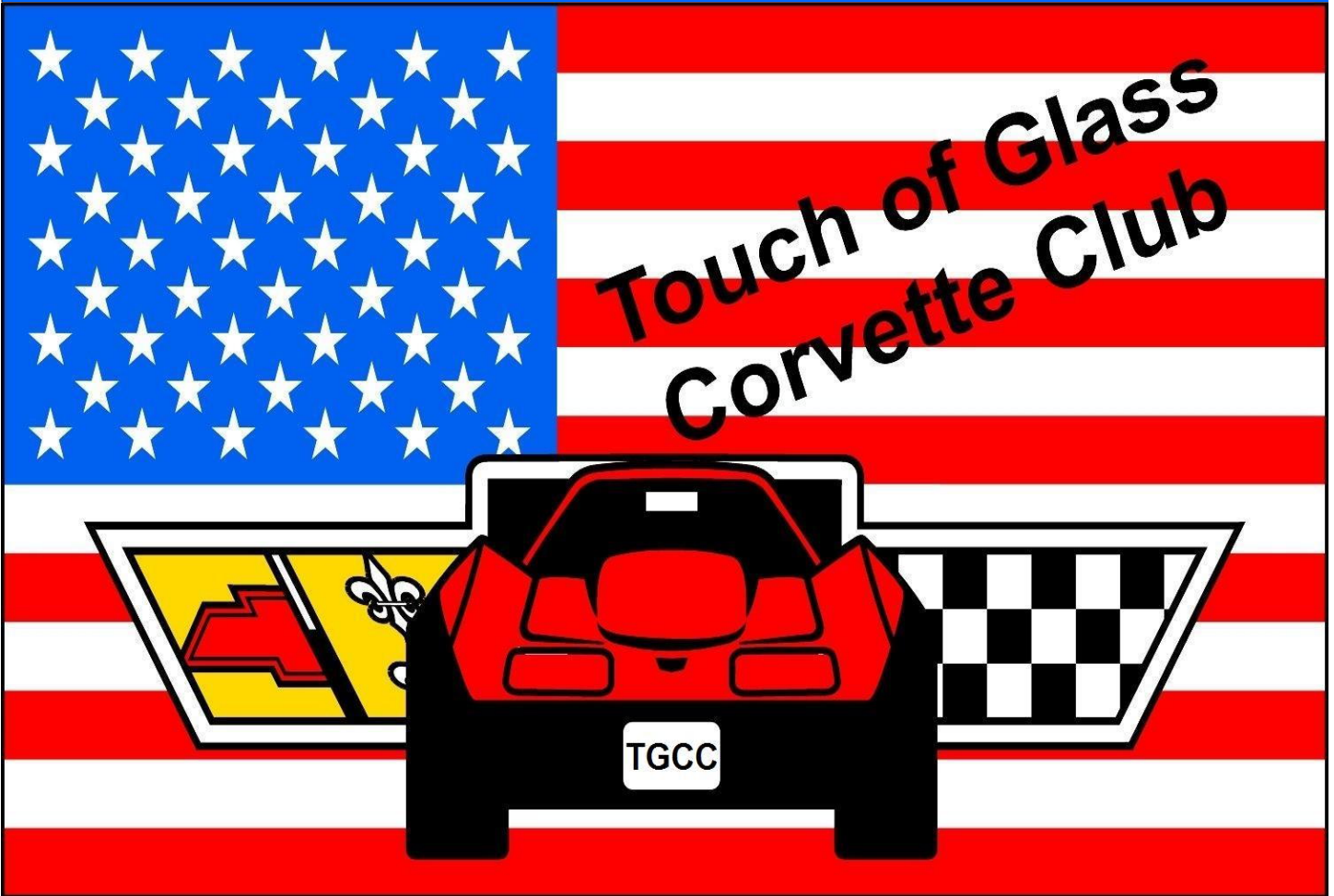
