Phil asked members if anyone had any questions regarding our car show and reminded us to hope for good weather.

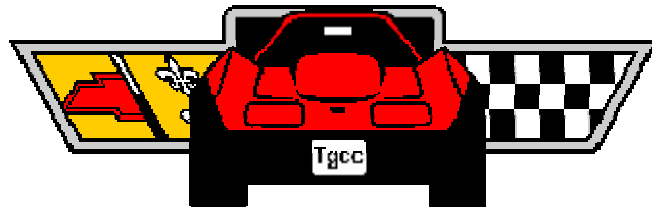
NEW BUSINESS 9

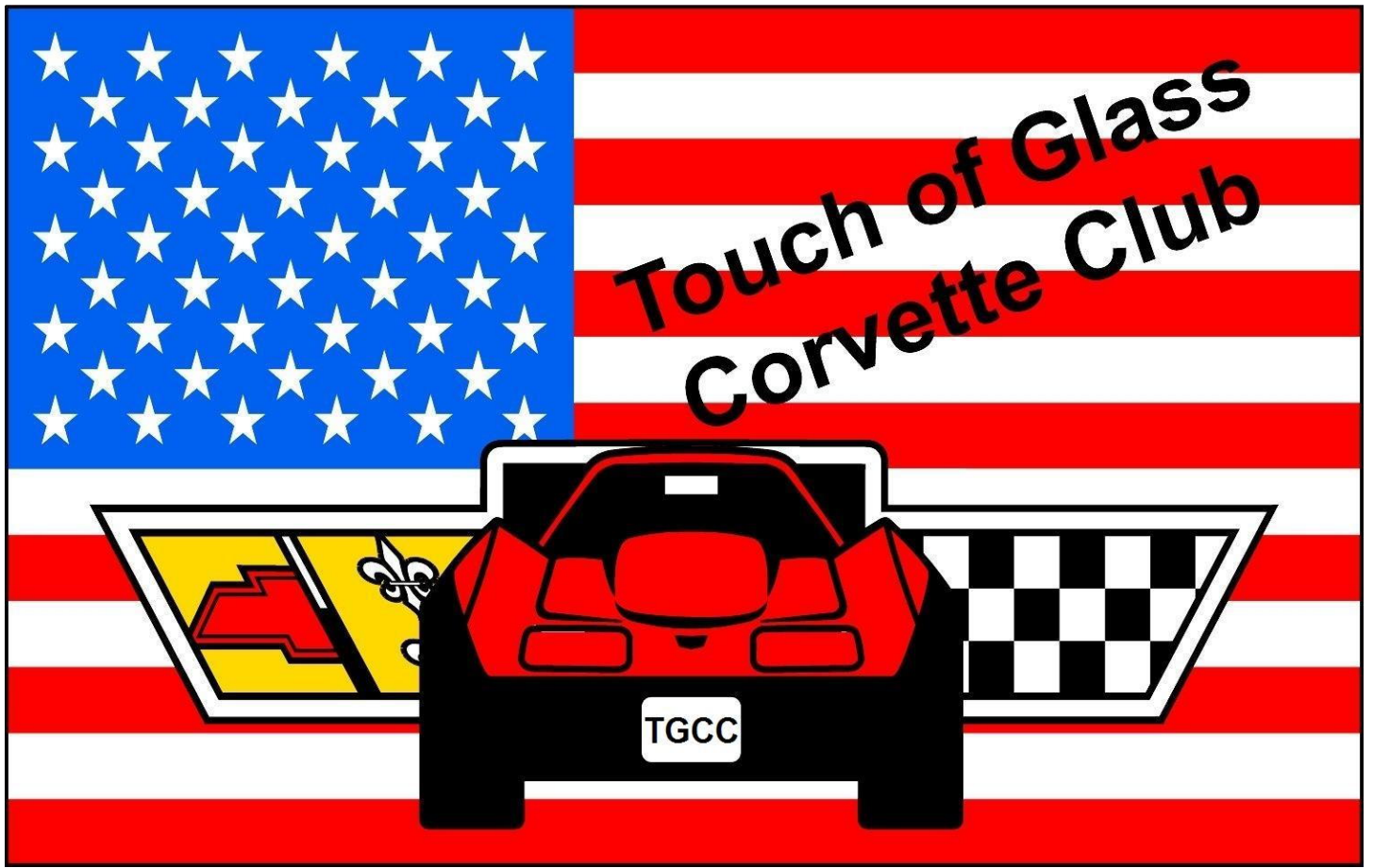
